- 1. The interaction of IMO regulations/Fit for 55 EU regulatory requirements creates a demanding context
- 2. There is **not enough time** to comply with regulations
- Implementing Energy Saving Devices is being evaluated
- In medium term key focus will be on diversifying the fuel composition of the fleet / Not a clear dominant fuel
- 5. Need for development of the required supply chain and port infrastructure for alternative fuels.
